## **Guidelines and Expectations**

- Projects may represent work done in class, co-curriculum courses, or personal interests outside of school.
- Projects should be hands-on for participants.
- Each project should be staffed with at least 2 students.
- Each project will be assigned a basic 6' table station. Additional space may be available upon request.
- Access to electricity is available upon request.
- Students showcasing projects are invited to attend STEAM Carnival for the full day, 8:00-3:30.
- Students will be assigned a four-hour showcase time. During unscheduled time, students are invited to participate in other carnival zones.
- Each project must have a district/campus sponsor that attends with the group, however a sponsor can supervise more than one project, if desired.
- Students included in the showcase are expected to be independent and interact appropriately with carnival participants.
- ESC Region 11 staff will be onsite, but will not be directly monitoring individual students.
- Transportation and attendance guidelines are provided by districts.
- ESC Region 11 is unable to provide transportation for showcase participants.
- ESC Region 11 is unable to provide absence waivers/excuses.
- Districts are responsible for obtaining appropriate parent/guardian permission.
