

## SECOND LANGUAGE ACCUSITION IN THE CLASSROOM ONLINE CANVAS COURSE

Designed for teachers of English Language Learners (ELLs), participants will be introduced to Cultural Identity, Second Language Acquisition Theory, and Sheltered Instruction. Participants will be able to (1) identify the definition of culture/cultural identity and the effect on teaching and learning; (2) demonstrate comprehension of the five hypotheses in Stephen Krashen's Second Language Acquisition theory; (3) demonstrate comprehension of BICS and CALPS, and (4) be able to identify at least four elements of Sheltered Instruction in a classroom lesson. Participants will receive six hours of CPE credit and have six weeks to complete this facilitated course. This course does not qualify as training in Sheltered Instruction needed for content-based ESL programs.
