Taught by Chief Fred Collie, Aledo ISD PD, and Chief Scott Collins, Aubrey ISD PD, The Standard Response Protocol - Extended (SRP-X) K-12 is based not on individual scenarios, but on the response to any given situation. Like the Incident Command System (ICS), SRP demands a specific vocabulary but also allows for great flexibility. The SRP is based on five actions: Lockout, Lockdown, Evacuate, Shelter, and Hold.

One critical aspect of crisis response is accountable reunification of students with their parents or guardians in the event of a school crisis or emergency. The Standard Reunification Method K-12 provides school and district safety teams with proven methods for planning, practicing, and achieving a successful reunification.
