In this five-day academy, beginning teachers of students receiving instruction in PreK, K, and special education settings for students ages 3-5 will:

- identify similarities and differences in rules, regulations, and research for pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, and special education services;
- review research-based strategies;
- discuss implications for specific classroom assignments; and
- develop and implement “application plans” implementing academy information in current classroom assignments. In-class time will be available to complete portions of individual application plans.

Campus administrators will receive resource materials to support implementation between sessions.

- This session is only for teachers who are in their 1st or 2nd year of teaching AND whose assignment is Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten, or special education classroom for 3s, 4s, and 5s.
- This session may be appropriate for teachers assigned to PreK, K, or PPCD settings after experiences in middle or high school grade levels. *Please contact Lynn Sullivan for details.

This training is not appropriate for:

- Teachers of older students who are functioning on this age level,
- veteran teachers who would like to refresh their knowledge and skills, or
- teachers assigned to PreK, K, or PPCD settings after experiences in other elementary grade levels.
