

# New Teacher ACADEMY

## Low Incidence Disabilities (LID)

- This three-day academy is for new teachers in self-contained, K-12+ settings for students with low-incidence disabilities (Significant Cognitive Disabilities, Medically Fragile).
- Participants must be in their first year of teaching in a self-contained LIFE Skills or Functional Academics-type classroom.
- An application is required with signatures from the campus administrator and participant prior to release of registration password.
- This will be a blended approach with online pre-work class and follow-up onsite technical assistance and Professional Learning Community (PLC) participation.
- Participants will receive and work with professional books to build their professional library.
- Participants will earn up to 24 CPEs. Maximum enrollment is 15.

**Prerequisite:** Once application has been approved, participants will receive the password for registration and information to complete the pre-work assignment in Canvas.

*\*Must have administrator approval in order to obtain password for registration. Participants will not be able to join the class without a completed application and welcome email from the instructor.\**
