## **Novice Teacher Training for Special Education Teachers of Students with Low-Incidence Disabilities – Fall**

Planning for timely data collection and grading during instruction will also be discussed. These activities will be placed in a digital bank that can be accessed by their colleagues. Six CPEs will be offered.

Participants will then have the opportunity to utilize the skills and insights learned on a student whom they currently have in their class.
